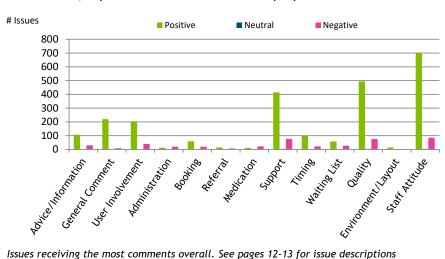

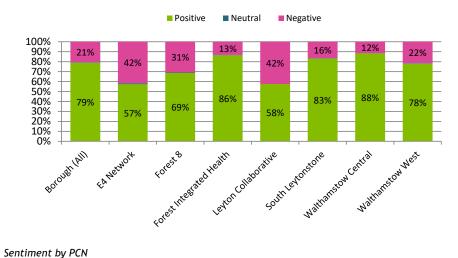

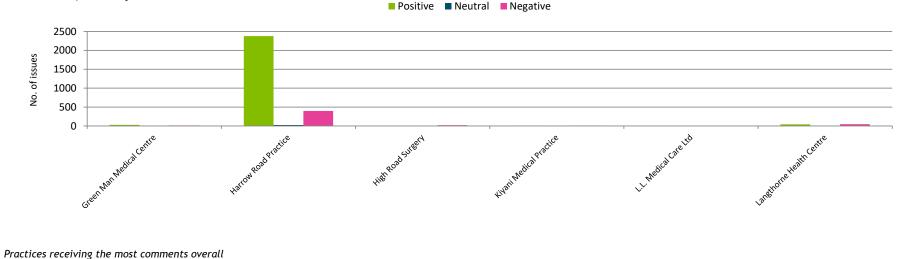
2.1.1 Overall, Top Trends: 2964 issues from 871 people



2.1.2 Overall, Sentiment by Primary Care Network



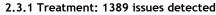

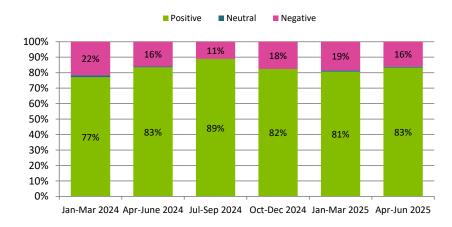

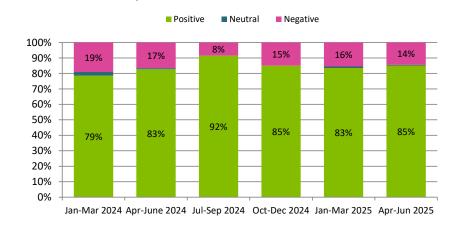

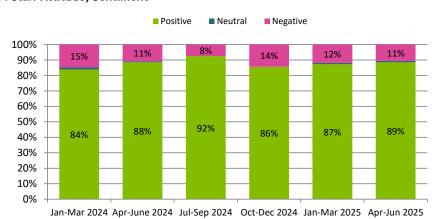

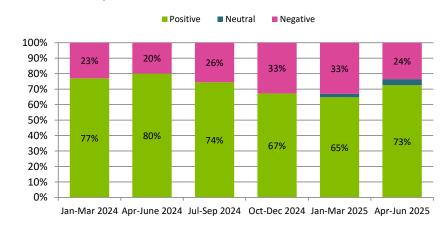
3.4 Staff Attitude, Sentiment

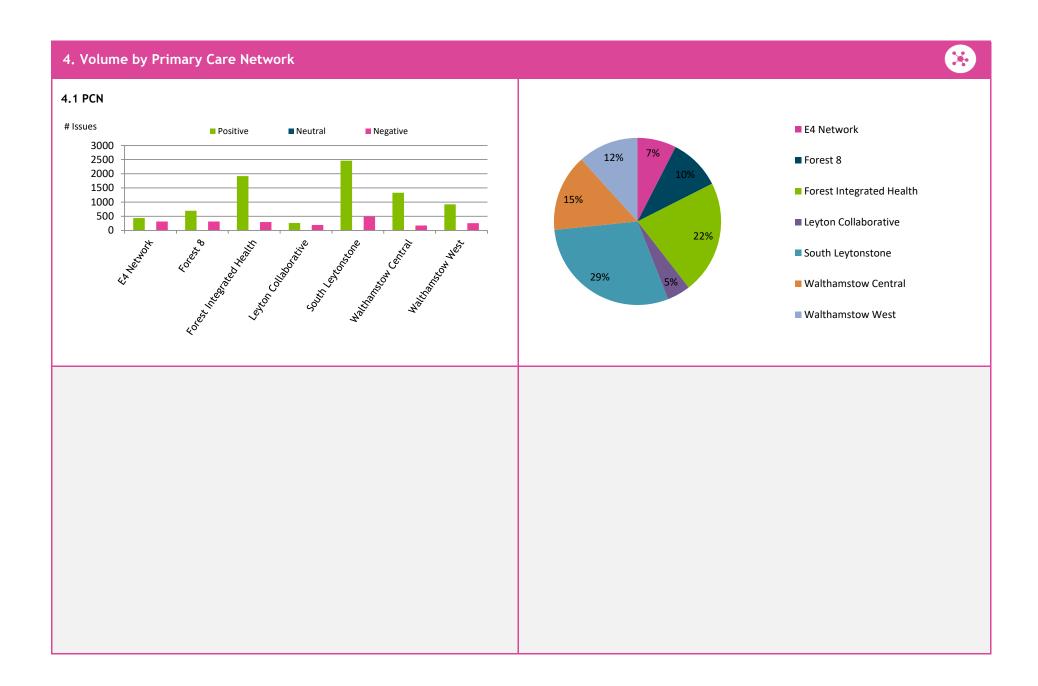
