Data Source

This report is based on the experience of 1,039 people. Feedback has been obtained from a variety of sources, including general engagement and comments posted online (including Care Opinion, NHS and social media). More on page 4.



Overall Satisfaction

Satisfaction has improved by 1% this quarter, standing at 75% positive, 24% negative and 1% neutral.

Feedback suggests people receive good quality, compassionate treatment and care on the whole, with good levels of involvement and communication. Service access remains as a leading negative topic. More on page 5.



Information, Involvement and Support

Satisfaction has improved by 1% this quarter, standing at 81% positive and 19% negative.

Complaints are down by 1% on both user involvement and support, while no change is recorded on communication. More on page 5.



Quality and Empathy

Satisfaction has improved by 2% this quarter, standing at 85% positive and 15% negative.

Good levels of quaility and empathy continue to be reported. More on page 5.



Access to Services

Satisfaction has improved by 2% this quarter, standing at 46% positive, 53% negative and 1% neutral.

Complaints are down by 5% on telephone access and by 1% on booking processes, while no change is recorded on waiting times. More on page 5.

GP Services

Satisfaction is at 67% positive, 32% negative and 1% neutral, according to feedback.

374 people comment on GP services. The majority of patients receive good quality, compassionate treatment and care, with good levels of involvement and support. Access related trends remain negative overall, this includes on booking processes, telephone access, administration and waiting lists. More on page 9.



Dentists

Comments suggest satisfaction is at 88% positive and 12% negative.

197 people comment on dentists, with accounts of excellent treatment, care and customer service recorded. Good levels of information and involvement are also reported. More on page 10.




Whipps Cross University Hospital


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


2. Health and Care Services: Which service aspects are people most commenting on?




